

VILLAGE STREET LIGHTING FOR SAFETY

Residents of villages such as Mamaila Kolobetona, Maphalle, Taulume Highmast and Ga-Ntata Highmast amongst others; are currently enjoying the benefit of streets lights in their respective communities.

Street lights provide a high quality and sustainable lighting solution for people in remote areas. This extends their day after the sun has set at an affordable cost, increasing the level of safety on roads and streets and allowing for more economic and social activities. More than 40 villages have benefitted from this project and more millions are still to be spent in assuring community members that their safety is a priority.

Economically, the Mayor highlighted that street lights helped many street traders as they can now be able to open their stalls until late without any hiccups. From social point of view, villagers will also feel free and safe to extend their hours. This creates a sense of safety in the villages as crime was increasing tremendously.
