

LIBRARIES FOR EDUCATIONAL GROWTH

The municipality is in the process of building three libraries in Mokwakwaila, Sekgopo and Senwamokgope respectively for the benefit of its citizens and others. It is the library that would inspire people to read since the construction of the library was meant to inculcate the culture of reading.

A budget of about R4.7 million has been put aside to finish these three projects to compliment the current libraries.

The mayor said people should not just read for the sake of reading, however, he advised that they should read for understanding, knowledge seeking and educational growth as the future of this municipality depends entirely on the knowledge gained by the youth. “We are building the libraries to keep people more knowledgeable through reading, and we believe this would be very much beneficial to them” he enthused.

He said people who have books and would like to donate them to the library should feel free, adding that library is The House of Knowledge, and no one must be denied entry to this house.

Currently the municipal libraries which are managed by the Department of Sports Arts and Culture within the municipality accessible to the community members are based in Kgapane, Soetfontein and Modjadjiskloof respectively.
